All submitted articles will be reviewed on a double-blind review basis. We may also invite contributors to serve as reviewers for this project.

- 1. Case Studies, Theoretical Paper or News: 1,500 to 3000 words.
- 2. Research Paper: 4,000 to 6,000 words (Please follow APA format) .
